

## HORTALEZA FIRE STATION (MADRID)

### Summary:

This fire station is designed to provide emergency response to twelve neighbourhoods of five districts in the northeast part of the city of Madrid (Fuencarral, Chamartín, Hortaleza, Ciudad Lineal and Barajas), which have an overall area of 6.600 hectares and a population of 300.000 residents. This fire station is also able to give support cover to another district of 800 hectares and 150.000 residents.

The building has the usual rooms (garages, sitting rooms, bedrooms, offices, etc.), a central telecommunications room and complete facilities for firemen training (classroom, fronton, gym, swimming pool for diving practice, smoke practice zone etc.), and facilities for equipment conservation, maintenance and set-up (washing room, stores, etc.)

The crew expected to use the fire station is 160 men, plus twelve fire vehicles.
